OUR OBJECTIVE

To sail the Carib Canoe "Gli Gli" with a crew of 12 Dominican Caribs from Antigua to the Virgin Islands, via Nevis and St. Kitts, St. Barths, St. Maarten/St. Martin and Anguilla then across the Anegada passage to Tortola during May of 2007.

The voyage is being undertaken to celebrate the tenth anniversary of Gli Gli's creation and to continue the mission of her 1997 expedition from Dominica to Guyana, by symbolically reuniting the Carib descendents of the Leeward Islands. The expedition intends to draw attention to the role the Carib tribe has played in the regions history and culture and to promote recognition of the Caribbean's largest surviving indigenous tribe. Throughout the expedition the crew will be presenting slide and video shows about the Gli Gli Carib Canoe Project and presenting traditional musical performances, and demonstrating their traditional crafts for schools and heritage groups.
